Home repair grant funding available for Hackensack-Walker home owners

Are you, or someone you know, in need of a new roof, furnace, windows, insulation or other essential housing repairs? Do you live in the city limits of Hackensack or Walker? Do you have low to moderate annual income? If you answered yes to these questions, you may be eligible for grant funding for these repairs through the Small Cities program.

Grants of up to \$20,000 are available for a limited time. Eligible applicants must own and live in their homes and be low income households. Households with less than the following annual income qualify:

- 1 Person, \$32,950
- 2 Person, \$37,700
- 3 Person, \$42,400
- 4 Person, \$47,100
- 5 Person, \$50,580
- 6 Person, \$54,650
- 7 Person, \$58,400
