

Walker gets state grant to fix industrial park infrastructure

The city of Walker received approval June 3 of its application for a Greater Minnesota Business Development Public Infrastructure Program grant from the Department of Employment and Economic Development (DEED).

The \$250,000 grant will provide financial assistance for Walker to help correct infrastructure difficulties in Walker's Industrial Park. The funds will help to provide the resources necessary for continued economic growth and encourage employment in the Walker community and nearby areas.

Walker sought specialized assistance from the Cass County Economic Development Corporation (EDC) to prepare the grant application.

The mission of the EDC is "to improve the business environment in Cass County by encouraging a strong, diverse and sustainable economy and to build better relationships between business, government agencies and communities."
