

Fix-up time in Backus and Longville with Small Cities grants

Applications for Small Cities grant funds are being accepted from residents in the cities of Longville and Backus who want to fix up their homes and businesses.

This is the best time of the year to start the application process in order to have the work completed over the summer.

Homeowners must live in the city limits of either community and earn a maximum of \$49,350 for a four person household. (Other levels apply as per household size). The grant can only be used on the primary home of the owner. Commercial properties must be located in the city limits of each city.

Bi-Cap is handling the field administration of these funds and interested applicants should contact them directly at (218) 751-4631. If you have applied already, make sure you have completed all of the documents and submitted them to Bi Cap. Once they have everything, they will complete your qualification processing and your application will be put on a first-come, first-served list.

The Cass County Economic Development Corporation (EDC) coordinated the project, so feel free to call them at (218) 947-7522. The EDC is a local non-profit corporation with the mission to “To attract and retain businesses in Cass County.”
